


Ladies Summer Book Club

12 Ways Your Phone is Changing You by Tony Reinke




The Hiding Place by Corrie ten Boom



Corrie ten Boom was a Dutch watchmaker who became a heroine of the Resistance, a survivor of Hitler's concentration camps, and one of the most remarkable evangelists of the 20th century. In World War II she and her family risked their lives to help Jews and underground workers escape from the Nazi's, and for their work they were tested in the infamous Nazi death camps. Here is the riveting account of how Corrie and her family were able to save many of God's Chosen People.
