- Private Fasts Done by an individual (1 Kings 214-5, Ezra 10:6, 1 Sam 1:7-8, Matt 4:1-2, Luke 4:1-2, Matt 1:18, Luke 7:4:1-2, Matt 11:18, Luke 7:33, 1 Sam 20:34, Ex. 34:28. Deut. 9:9, Deut. 9:18, Neh. 1:4, Acts 9:9, 2 Cor. 6:5, 2 Cor. 11:27, 1 Sam 28:20, 2 Sam 11:11)
- Public Fasts Called by leaders OT Sacred Assemblies (Judg. 20:26, 1 Sam. 7:6, Est. 4:15-16, Matt. 9:14, Mark 2:18, Luke 5:33, Acts 13:1-3, Acts 23:12-13. Acts 27:33),

- Complete fasts no food or water (not recommended) (Exodus 34:28, Deut. 9:9, Deut. 9:18, 1 Kings 19:8, Ezra 10:6,1Sam 30:12, Acts 9:9)
- Supernatural fasts (Exodus 34:28, Deut. 9:9, Deut. 9:18, 1 Kings 19:8) God empowers a miraculous fast with no food or water for 40 days or more
